Overview


Our products have many different Bluetooth connection modes. When you use a Samsung device to connect to the scanner, if you change the Bluetooth connection mode (for example, from HID mode to SPP mode), you need to follow the following process, otherwise you will be unable to connect.

NOTES: This document is only for Samsung device.


Operation

You have connected the device with BT-HID before. Now if you want to use BT-SPP mode, please follow the steps below.


Step 1. Tap settings on your phone



Step 2. Select connections




Step 3. Select Bluetooth



Step 4. In the paired list, find the Bluetooth name of the scanner and tap the position marked in the red box.



Step 5. Tap Unpair



Step 6. Scan BT-SPP Mode bar code.
